

Foursquare 2017 Youth Camp Registration Package

Instructions:

1. Read the camp fact sheet to learn some important details about registration and what to expect at camp this year.
2. Complete the two consent forms. In addition to the Foursquare Youth Camp consent form, Stillwood Camp also requires an additional consent form for the use of their facilities.

4. Complete the payment form and send it in with payment to complete your registration.

Thanks for registering for camp! Here's the important details you need to gear up for this year!

Forms: You must complete your consent and payment forms. If you haven't done so, you can download the forms from our website: www.foursquareyouth.ca

Cost: This year camp registration early-bird price is \$340 (\$355 after Jul 15) and includes your waterslide ticket. We have reduced the price of our T-shirts - only \$10 more! We also recommend money for snacks (\$20 each), which is paid with your registration fee. Check the website and payment form for more details.

Payment: You must submit your payment with the forms for your registration to be accepted. You may mail your payment to: "Foursquare Youth Camp", Northside Church, 1460 Lansdowne Drive, Coquitlam, B.C., V3E 2N9. **Submit your forms and payment by July 15 for the lower early bird price!**

Youth Camp will only accept full payments for campers. If you are paying a portion and your church is paying a portion (for sponsorship or fundraising) your church will collect your fees and pay the full amount to camp. DO NOT send partial payments to the camp directly, which is different from last year. Thanks!

Ages: Youth camp is for campers entering grade 8 in the fall of 2017 and all grades including grade 12 students graduating this year.

Arrival/Pickup: Registration is from 5:30-6:30 pm Sunday August 27. Late registration is possible, just send us an email through our website to let us know you are coming late. There is no dinner served on the first night of camp. Camp ends 10:30 am, Friday September 1.

What to bring: sleeping bag / extra blanket / pillow / flashlight / warm clothes / a modest swim suit / personal items / beach towel / Bible / notebook / pen / theme costume

Leave at home: electronic devices like tablets, phones, etc... **Camp is a TECH FREE environment.** If you bring an ipod, music player, game system, laptop, or cell phone, our Head Counselors will store it for you for safe keeping for the week. Better to just leave them at home. You can always make any calls if you need to by simply asking your counselor to access a phone. Campers who drive themselves will have to park their vehicles for the week. The Head Counselors will hold on to your keys to keep them safe.

Themes: We have three theme events throughout camp: bad hair day (show your crazy hair at breakfast one morning), clash day (show us your worst style at breakfast one morning) and our major theme event: the Costume Competition. Dress up in a theme costume, this year it's "90's Throwback" – I'm talkin' POGs (Google it!), glitter, Tamagochis, "Not!", Boy Bands, "Talk to the Hand!" and sooo much more. Celebrate the decade of bleached hair and ripped jeans that you missed out on the first time around. All three theme events are an opportunity to help your team win extra points for creativity and effort!

Facilities: Youth camp is held again this year at Stillwood Camp and Conference Centre (www.stillwood.ca). A map with directions and link to Google earth are available on our website at www.foursquareyouth.ca.

This is a **NON-SMOKING** camp. Due to regulations there are no smoking areas on or off the property. Violators will be sent home. Thanks for your co-operation.

Parent's Legal Consent & Release:

I, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge and declare that I am the parent and/or legal guardian of the camper identified on this registration. I understand and appreciate that my said son/daughter will attend the B.C. Foursquare Youth Summer Camp for the dates August 27 to September 1, 2017. I hereby give my irrevocable consent for my son/daughter to attend with the Representatives of the Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada ("Foursquare staff") at the said camp. I declare that my son/daughter is covered by Medical Insurance. I hereby give to the Foursquare staff irrevocable authority to act in my place and stead and to authorize any and all medical treatment which may be necessary for my son/daughter. I hereby consent to Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada incurring all reasonable costs for providing food, shelter, transportation and medical treatment for my son/daughter and I agree that I shall indemnify the Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada for any costs incurred on behalf of my son/daughter in this regard.

I, the undersigned, hereby declare that I understand and appreciate the nature of the camp which my son/daughter, will attend with Foursquare staff and the risks that such activities entail. Accordingly, I hereby renounce and relinquish all my rights and the rights of my said son/daughter of whom I acknowledge that I am the parent and legal guardian, to make any claim by legal action or otherwise either personally or through third parties on my behalf or on behalf of my son/daughter against the Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada, its directors, officers, employees, agents and or representatives for any accident or injury my son/daughter may suffer or any loss or damage of personal property my son/daughter may incur while attending the camp with Foursquare staff. I also agree to indemnify and save harmless the Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada from any and all debts and liabilities arising from the said camp and shall keep the Foursquare Gospel Church of Canada indemnified in respect of such debts and liabilities. I acknowledge having read the foregoing, and I understand and agree with the same. I also attest to the completeness and accuracy of all registration information.

I understand that the camp is a public place and that individuals may take personal photographs and/or videos, and that the camp also produces a video (the "camp memory video") for the purposes of distribution to the camp attendees and its participating churches. In this video several campers and staff are shown very briefly, participating in the activities which are part of the camp program. I understand that my son or daughter may be photographed during his/her participation in the camp and that the camp does not control cameras being used for personal use. I further give my consent for my son/daughter to be photographed/filmed by camp staff for the purpose of producing the camp memory video and its distribution in recorded format or via the internet, including Facebook.

By signing this consent form I further agree that I and my son/daughter understand the camp's policies and that my son/daughter will abide by the policies of the camp as they pertain to campers.

It is also designed to provide some information regarding the hazards and risks that are present when these programs are conducted, in order to help parents make informed decisions regarding their child's participation.

The following programs are conducted by **Stillwood Camp**. Since 1958, we have been providing quality outdoor programs to thousands of children. Our professional guides and instructors (should you use them) have been selected for their experience in the outdoors and ability to provide each participant with an outstanding experience in a natural outdoor setting. Our attention to detail in risk management and staff training contribute to our excellent safety record.

Your child may be participating in some or all of the following activities:

Kayaking Archery Hiking Canoeing
 Low/High Ropes Challenge Nature Studies Rock Climbing / Rappelling
 Team Building Evening Campfires Overnight Camping

These programs will be conducted rain or shine. It is important that participants dress appropriately and be prepared for any weather. This means dressing in warm layered clothing that can be added or removed depending on the conditions. Fleece or thick sweaters on top of a T-shirt / sweatshirt and long pants will be adequate. Don't forget to include rain gear, a hat, sun screen, gloves, and any medication your child may require. Immersion in water is not intended but is a possibility, **please include a complete change of clothes including shoes and socks.**

Whenever these types of outdoor activities are conducted, there are natural hazards and risks. In addition to the usual risks, dangers and hazards can present themselves in outdoor activities and programs and may involve additional risks such as:

- changing weather conditions such as wet, icy, or slippery conditions that may result in falls;
- climbing on steep or vertical slopes that may result in falls or falling rock;
- Immersion in water that may result in hypothermia or drowning;
- travel through forest environments which may result in injury from trees, branches, sticks, etc;
